- a) To establish an integrated body of Licensed Firearms Dealers, Gunsmiths, Theatrical Armorer's, Prohibited Weapons Dealers, Club Armorer's, Shooting Clubs, Collectors and other associated trades, whether they require a license or permit of any kind or not, under current State or Federal firearms legislation.
- b) To provide members with strong, unified representation and voice when dealing with Governments and other bodies.
